The New York Library Association's Leadership and Management Academy is an educational program for emerging leaders in the library profession. Participants will gain the skills and knowledge needed to advance up the career ladder in library management. Enrollment in the Leadership and Management Academy is limited initially to 40 students each year. Enrollees are required to complete ten courses over a three-year period to receive a Leadership and Management Academy Certificate.

Qualifying courses will be held at the NYLA Annual Conference in the fall, and in June. This set of offerings covers two of the ten courses required for completion of the Certificate.

Who should attend?

The Academy is designed for mid-career library professionals interested in obtaining the practical knowledge and basic skills critical to becoming a library leader or manager. Applicants must either have five years of library experience and a Bachelors Degree or two years of library experience and an MLS. NYLA membership is a requirement of enrollment.
