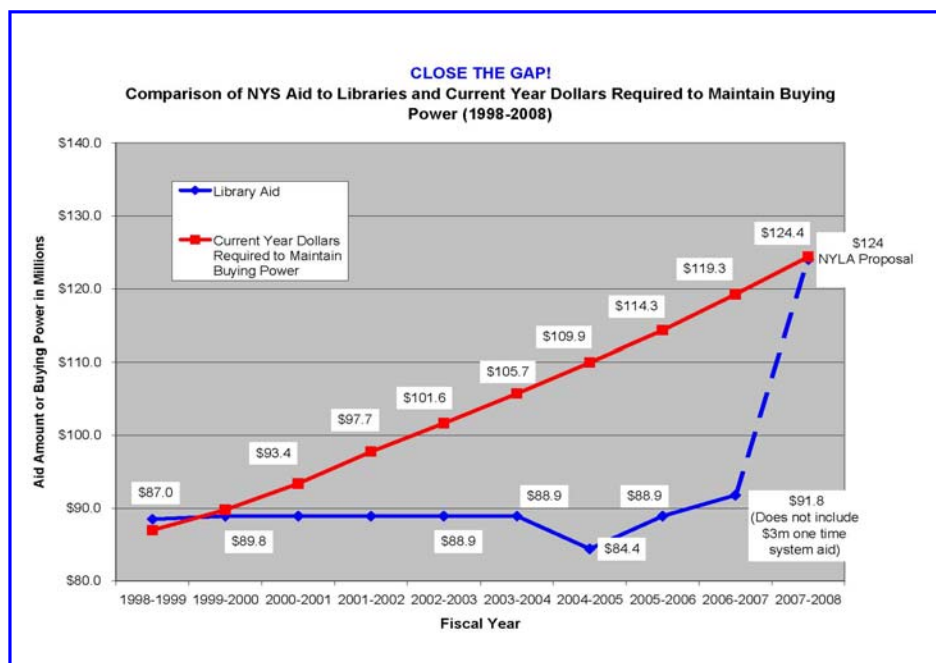




Close the gap for libraries
