## Driving Directions:

**From the East:** From Route 22 or the Taconic State Parkway go west on Routes 44 or 55. These two routes join in Poughkeepsie to form the westbound arterial. Follow the arterial around the Grand Hotel, staying in the middle lane. At the second light make a left onto the eastbound arterial. From the eastbound arterial (Church Street) make a right (south) at the first light onto Market Street. The System is on the left in the second block.

**From the West:** From the Thruway or Route 9W go east on combined Routes 44 and 55. After crossing the Mid-Hudson Bridge, turn right (south) at the third light, onto Market Street. The System is on the left in the second block.

**From Route 9N or Route 9S:** Exit to combined Routes 44 and 55 East. At the third light, turn right on Market Street. System is on the left in the second block.
