2009 Pied Piper Award

Criteria for Submission

All submissions must have been created and/or implemented within the twelve months prior to December 1st of the award year. For example, the 2009 award will be awarded for promotional materials produced OR programs implemented between January 1, 2008 and December 1, 2008.

Promotional material submissions: may include flyers, bookmarks, booklists, kits tutorials or other promotional materials created for a programs or a special library event. Please submit three (3) original color hard copies **AND** one electronic copy of all materials. When mailing, please write, "Pied Piper Award Submission" on package. The electronic copy may either be files burned onto a CD **OR** e-mailed to the Chair of the committee. If submitting through e-mail, please type in "Pied Piper Award electronic submission" in the subject box.

Program submissions: must include instructions, how the program was implemented, who the intended audience of the program was, publicity generated about the program and the results achieved. Please submit three (3) original color hard copies **AND** one electronic copy of all materials. When mailing, please write, "Pied Piper Award Submission" on package. The electronic copy may either be files burned onto a CD **OR** e-mailed to the Chair of the committee. If submitting through e-mail, please type in "Pied Piper Award electronic submission" in the subject box.

Deadline: December 5, 2008. The winner will be announced at the 2009 YSS Spring Conference.

Please note:

- * The Director of the winning library will receive a letter to inform him/her of award.
- * Executive Board members and Pied Piper Committee members may not apply for the Pied Piper Award during their term of office.
- * All materials must be submitted by December 5th of the award year. For example, all materials submitted for the 2009 award must be received by December 5, 2008.
- * All materials submitted must be free of all copyright restrictions. The copyright statement on the application form must be signed.
- * By submitting an entry, all responsible parties agree that other librarians may use, reproduce, and/or adapt the work to their own needs, provided proper credit is given. The basic concept of the printed material or program must be relatively easy to reproduce.

Those responsible for submission of the winning submission may be asked to do one of the following:

- Create a presentation board to be displayed during the YSS Spring Conference
- Supply copies of their publication or program information for distribution to YSS members at the Spring Conference.
- Present their program at the YSS roundtable during NYLA Conference or the following year's YSS Spring Conference.
